#### **Program Description**

Thank you for your interest in the Health Information Technology Associate in Applied Science Degree. The Health Information Technology program prepares the graduate to take an active role in the field of health information management. Graduates will interact with physicians, health professionals, financial and administrative staffs to ensure the protection of information systems. Graduates will help determine health information budgets, resources and policies, utilizing current and accurate data. The curriculum includes course work in the supporting sciences and general education areas. Classroom instruction is supplemented with learning experiences in the campus laboratory and in area health care facilities. Students enrolled in the Health Information Technology Program are required to achieve a minimum of grade of “C” in each Health Information Technology course. Health information technicians are employed in hospitals, medical clinics, nursing homes, other health care facilities and industry.

Graduates may choose to take the Certified Coding Associate (CCA), Certified Coding Specialist (CCS), or Certified Coding Specialist – Physician Office (CCS-P) coding examination(s) offered by the American Health Information Management Association. Graduates may also choose to take the Certified Professional coder (CPC) or certified Professional Coder-Hospital (CPC-H) offered by the American Academy of Professional Coders (AAPC).
