This certificate is offered by the following colleges: <u>Ashland Community & Technical College</u>, <u>Big Sandy Community & Technical College</u>, <u>Bluegrass Community & Technical College</u>, <u>Elizabethtown Community & Technical College</u>, <u>Gateway Community & Technical College</u>, <u>Hazard Community & Technical College</u>, <u>Hopkinsville Community College</u>, <u>Henderson Community College</u>, <u>Jefferson Community & Technical College</u>, <u>Madisonville Community College</u>, <u>Maysville Community & Technical College</u>, <u>Owensboro Community & Technical College</u> and <u>Somerset Community College</u>.

One of these colleges must be designated as your Home College. Even though the classes will be delivered by different KCTCS colleges, only the Home College will admit you and take care of all of your student service needs including advising, library services, billing, financial aid, and most importantly, awarding the certificate.

Getting Started

Students may register for KCTCS online classes offered system wide directly at any KCTCS college. Individuals may also complete a "course inquiry" submit form through www.kyvc.org. KYVC course inquiries are submitted directly to the KCTCS Home College identified by the student. The student's chosen Home College processes the course inquiry either through formal admission procedures or class enrollment. IMPORTANT: All students are required to have annual liability insurance that can be obtained through their home college. Students taking IECE classes must have a CANS criminal check and a current TB test (within two years). These are required because IECE courses have observation hours in childcare settings.
