Program Description

Thank you for your interest in the Associate in Applied Science Quality Management Systems Quality Specialist I Certificate.

The Quality Specialist I Certificate will provide fundamental knowledge of basic quality principles, customer focus, and long term planning, and helping people work to their optimum. Upon completion of the certificate, the student will be qualified to take industry designed and recognized certification examinations. Employment opportunities include entry-level positions to support and troubleshoot Process Control and Systems standardization. Colleges

This certificate is offered by <u>Elizabethtown Community and Technical College</u> and <u>Hopkinsville Community College</u>.

One of these colleges must be designated as your "Home College". Some of the required certificate classes (such as QMS 101) may be delivered by different KCTCS colleges.
